Revise the following sentences and passages to correct sentence fragments.

1. The access mechanism of the floppy disk drive contains two motors. One motor that rotates a floppy disk at 300 rotations per minute (rpm). Another motor is used to move the read-write head inward and outward on the tracks of the disk.
2. Modern strain gauges are manufactured by etching a very thin metal foil through a mask to obtain a grid pattern. The foil having been previously coated with a thin layer of epoxy to form the gauge backing.
3. Paperboard aseptic packaging has already revolutionized the beverage industry. Taking over a significant market share from metal cans and glass bottles. Developments in technology mean a rapid increase in production of more radical packaging. Plastic multilayer, high-barrier containers.
4. A vendor evaluation system should increase the number of good vendors and decrease the number of bad vendors. The effect being the acquisition of quality parts on time and at a reasonable price, lowering the overall product cost.
